beams – this may look like a Manhattan loft, but it's actually the top floor of a north London Victorian terrace. "The owners removed the ceiling to create a double-height living space," says designer Rhiannon Phenis. "Technically it's a loft conversion but the execution and materials make it so much more." The kitchen is similarly dynamic, reflecting the couple's zest for life.

LAYOUT

A walk-in pantry hosts floor-to-ceiling storage, allowing for fewer cabinets in the open-plan living space. There's a table to come, and a sofa or two, so the couple didn't want to fill the room with "kitchen". The island is a statement piece, and there's a neat working area between hob and sink.

FURNITURE

"The owners wanted something different and we spent hours poring over material samples and finishes before hitting on this combination of burnished brass and charcoal laminate," says Rhiannon. All the base units feature drawers rather than cupboards, making them far more practical. "They have lots of room for everyday crockery and pans."

SURFACES

The burnished brass island is topped in vintage oiled oak. "We considered stainless steel but wood is so much nicer to lean on," says Rhiannon. Steel is used at the sink area, where a wide section of formed steel with integral bowl protects the wood from water.

APPLIANCES

A steam oven, multifunctional oven and wine fridge are lined up below the gas hob of the island. The dishwasher is integrated on the sink run and the fridge-freezer is in the pantry. "There are very few appliances on view from the living space," says Rhiannon.

LIGHTING AND ACCESSORIES

Industrial-style spotlights, which match the gunmetal of the beam, direct lighting onto the island. There are also spots tucked under the shelving on the back wall, which can be angled onto the worktop for task lighting.
